



## STANDARD CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

Consignor agrees to place the item(s) listed below on consignment with OnPoint Solutions Inc. (OnPoint) to try to sell under the terms of this agreement. OnPoint agrees to accept the item(s) listed below for consignment sale under the terms of this agreement.

Consignor represents that they are the rightful owner of the item(s) listed, and that the item(s) are free of any encumbrance. Consignor will need to show appropriate government-issued identification for the type of firearm they want to consign.

Consignor agrees that, as OnPoint is required to complete inspections, cleaning and preparations of the item(s) for sale, that the items consigned will be left on consignment with OnPoint for a minimum of 120 days.

OnPoint will manage and market the item(s) for sale as follows:

- 1) Visually inspect each item for noticeable external defects. Firearms will be inspected and fired. Consignor will provide one magazine or cylinder of ammunition for test firing.
- 2) Item(s) will be surface cleaned and maintained for very best possible retail presentation.
- 3) Item(s) will be displayed at our retail location during the initial 120-day period.
- 4) Item(s) will be fully insured for the net amount due consignor.
- 5) All cases and accessories included as part of the sale will be bagged and stored securely.

Optional Services available at additional charge include:

- 1) Full written appraisal
- 2) Deep cleaning of the firearm

At the end of 60 days, the initial sale price will be re-evaluated by OnPoint, subject to approval by Consignor, and the item(s) will be re-marketed in accordance with the marketing plan notated above.

At the end of 120 days consignor will be contacted to discuss alternate marketing strategies and further price reduction.

When the item(s) consigned are sold, the consignor's net amount will be paid seven business days from the date that the item(s) have been paid for and delivered to the buyer. Payment will be mailed to the address stipulated below. The consignor must provide OnPoint with written notification of any change in address. OnPoint will yield a standard commission of 25% of the selling price in addition to any credit card or other fees if applicable.

After the initial 120-day period, either party has the right to terminate this agreement by providing 30 days' written notice to the other party at the addresses stipulated below.

If a North Carolina consignor decides to have consigned firearm(s) returned to them, Federal Law requires that the consignor provide the necessary permits, fill in the appropriate forms, and have a NICS check performed if required, as if they were purchasing the firearms. Further, State Law requires the consignor to present their current Driver's License and North Carolina Concealed Carry Permit or Pistol Purchase Permit with matching addresses to order to have a handgun returned to them. A fee for the transfer will apply.



If an out of state consignor decides to have consigned firearm(s) returned to them, Federal Law requires that we ship the firearm(s) to an FFL Dealer to retake possession of your firearm. Shipping and insurance charges, payable in advance, will apply.
